To set up a Children's Home & educational complex at Wellavaya Provincial Council Area, Moneragala Dist, Sri Lanka for 200 Tsunami affected children

Background

Sunday, the December 26, 2004 unleashed a tragedy that had killed more than 30,000 people and displace more than 500,000 people in Sri Lanka. In order to rehabilitate the children affected by Tsunami, IAHV in association with Art of Living Foundation, Sri Lanka proposed to set up a childcare and education complex at Wellavaya. The proposal was approved by Unibanco Foundation.

The construction of children's residence and classrooms are completed as of December 30, 2006. An official permit is pending from Child Care Probation Ministry which comes under the Child Development Ministry. The process of inspection has been completed by the department of children's affairs. Once the approval is completed the orphanage can house 150 – 200 children.
